







REPORTED SPEECH

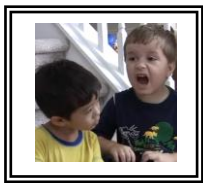

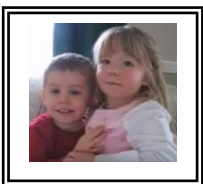
